




Priscilla was the daughter of Joshua Dodgson and the sister of Jonathan, both of whom had been founder members and Trustees of Central Hall and (Jonathan later) Southgate. Joshua had died in 1870 and Jonathan in 1909. Priscilla had married Joseph Horsfall whose mother was also a Dodgson.

Priscilla died in 1893 and Joseph in 1905: they lived in Newcombe Street, off Huddersfield Road.

Aquila, who had been the manager of a cotton mill at Springhead (near Oldham), which was then in the West Riding, laid the stone in memory of his parents. He died in 1945.
